

## **STRETTON ON DUNSMORE PARISH COUNCIL**

### **School Crossing Patrol Officer (SCPO)**

Based on the results of a recent site survey of the Fosse Way at peak times during term time, and the recommendations of Warwickshire County Council the process for advertising for a new School Crossing Patrol Officer have been halted. The Parish Council will liaise with the School and WCC to reassess the need for a SCPO before the intake of children to Knightlow School in September 2017. During this period without a SCPO, the Parish Council remind all drivers to be extra vigilant when entering and leaving the village during peak times. Further to this, it would be pleased to hear from any residents who would be willing to volunteer to turn on and off the crossing patrol lights located on the Fosse Way, on a twice daily basis during term time.

### **Green Bins**

The Parish Council have been informed that Rugby Borough Council have taken the decision to cease green bin collections between December 2016 and March 2017.

### **RBC Local Plan**

The second phase of consultation is now underway regarding RBC Local Plan, in which 75 houses are to be built in Stretton. The Parish Council has already objected to this siting concerns about the build being on greenbelt, increased traffic and flooding risk, and the already oversubscribed amenities within the village i.e.: School and Doctors surgery.
