

STRETTON ON DUNSMORE PARISH COUNCIL

AED

The Parish Council have been working with Vanessa Braithwaite, Ian Taggart and the Ambulance Service to locate three AEDs (Defibrillators) in the public domain. The Ambulance Service have updated and serviced all three AEDs free of charge. The Parish Council have purchased new batteries under the advice of the Ambulance Service. The cost of two cabinets to house two of the AEDs has been split between the Parish Council and the First Responders Fund. Based on the recommendations of the Ambulance Service, one of the AEDs will be located on the side of the village hall hopefully by the end of November. Another AED will be installed on Rugby Lane, near the property of Paul Gordon. When the location of the third has been agreed the Parish Council will share this information.

School Crossing Patrol Officer

While Stretton is without a School Crossing Patrol Officer, the Parish Council are urging all motorists to be extra vigilant when driving through the village at the beginning and end of the school day. It would also ask parents to either accompany their children across Fosse Way or remind them to take extra care. Warwickshire County Council are in the process of advertising the position. In the meantime, the Parish Council have contacted the Safer Neighbourhood Team to make them aware that the village children are crossing without an aid, in the hope they will increase Police presence during the peak times.

Speed Watch

In a bid to reduce the speed of the traffic travelling through the village, six volunteers from Stretton and four from Princethorpe have agreed to undertake Speed Gun training. Each volunteer must be 'vetted' by the Police before they start the training. The department responsible for processing the vetting forms has three month back log, as a result the Speed Gun training has been postponed to 14th January 2017.

The next public Parish Council meeting will be held on **Monday 10th October 2016 at 7.30pm** at Knightlow School. The agenda will be available on the website and noticeboard 7 days in advance.
