Community Speed Watch

The Stretton & Princethorpe Community Speed Watch Team went out to monitor traffic on the Fosse Way in July. They clocked and recorded four vehicles travelling at over 35mph in a 45 minute period and passed the vehicle number plates to the police. The Speed Watch's results cannot be used to enforce any penalties however, each speeding driver will receive a letter from the police and the information is retained so any regular speed breaker can be identified by the police and dealt with accordingly. Basic First Aid Training
