



The Stretton on Dunsmore History Society has had another successful year with a wide variety of talks and events. Our interactive display at the village fete was popular and stimulated some interesting reminiscences. Our programme of talks including: Memories of growing up in Stretton; the Past beneath our Feet; the History of the BTH site in Rugby; Barnes Wallis and the Dam Busters; Cordelia Leigh's Diaries from WWI; a Costumed account of life for Roman women (joint with the Ladies Fellowship) and research based on the 1913 Valuation Survey.
